Upper Valley Presents' Rock School is a community-based educational program that teaches creativity, teamwork, social skills and builds self-esteem through musical instrumentation, song writing, singing, and recording. Our mission is to create a positive atmosphere in which students are motivated and encouraged through hands-on learning to achieve their own personal fulfillment. We strive to bring communities together, to reach out to kids, young or old, and to create an atmosphere that truly Rocks! From here, we will expand our vision and hope that other communities will recognize the value that music plays in the lives of our students and audiences everywhere.
